Early-career clinicians are trained in evidence-based practices and are placed throughout the NYC Health + Hospitals system with the goal of emerging from the three-year program seasoned and adept clinicians. Under the supervision of licensed clinicians, Corps Members will be equipped to screen, assess, and treat patients in a culturally competent manner. The program is operated by NYC Health + Hospitals and supported by the Mayor's Office of ThriveNYC.
